What: Pathfinder Teen Canoe Trip

When: October 2, 2021

Where: Santiam and Willamette Rivers near Salem, Oregon

Why: It's a great way to experience some cool rivers.

Who: All Oregon Teen Pathfinders (7th grade and up)



Cost and Registration:

The cost is \$10.00 per person before September 23, the registration deadline. This includes lunch, equipment and some transportation. After September 23, the cost is \$20.00 per person. Please sign up early to reserve a spot. The number of spots is limited, so sign up soon. Registered teens will be given priority.

Consent & Release Form:

As with all Pathfinder events a valid Permission and Medical Consent Form must accompany each Pathfinder. Please bring 1 copy for the club and 1 copy for the teen to carry with them.

What to bring:

- Teen Pathfinders and a staff for about every four Pathfinders.
- Consent Form.
- Shoes that you can get wet. Flip flops do not work well in rivers but old tennis shoes with wool socks do.
- Synthetic clothes that dry quickly and a swimsuit for underneath (you ~~might~~ will get wet). Fleece, polyester or nylon are good choices. Don't wear cotton!
- Water bottle on a rope, sunscreen, hat, etc. Prepare to be outside all day.
- Dry clothes and a towel for when you get back to the cars.
- Face Mask – required when the group is on land (but not required or recommended on the water)

Day in a Nutshell:

Pathfinder clubs will meet at the boat launch in Jefferson, Oregon on Sabbath morning at 10:00 am. Pathfinders who register should be prepared to get wet. We will launch from there into the Santiam River. We will continue to where the Santiam joins the Willamette River. Our takeout point will be Buena Vista Ferry. There will be stops along the way for breaks and lunch. We plan to arrive back at the cars around 4 or 5 pm.
